

Summary

- The project involved 2 weeks of planning
- (10 Powerpoint lessons and a Google Sketchup plan),
- 1 week of working on the space from 6.30am 8am and 5 full days of construction.
- The students worked in small groups of 4. Four groups (16 students) designed and constructed the path up to the main space.
- Seven groups worked in the main circle (diameter 24m) on the decorations, furniture, sculptures, planting, shelter, games and lighting.
- All material used was bought locally or re used from waste material at Vigyan Ashram. In the end, Rs 8286 was spent.
